As Ashford Community Safety unit there has been the following good work:

Officers from the Ashford Beat Team identified a vehicle linked to the supply of controlled drugs in the Ashford area. This lead to the subsequent arrest of 2 people, and searches of the vehicle and a property lead to suspected Class A drugs, money and stolen items located within. Both suspects are currently on bail. Drugs have a detrimental effect on communities. Those who distribute drugs will continue to be targeted by Kent Police.

Officers from the Ashford Beat Team were recently contact by a member of the public, who disrupted 3 males hotwiring a motorbike in the South Ashford area. After determined efforts from local officers, 3 suspects were identified and within a short period of time all 3 suspects were arrested. The motorbike had been confirmed as stolen from the day before and returned to it's rightful owner.
