- **Drink and Drug Driving Awareness** Alcohol and drugs can remain in your system for many hours, meaning you may still be over the legal limit the following morning when you wish to drive. Even if you feel fine, your reaction times and judgment may still be impaired. Plan ahead by arranging a designated driver, booking a taxi, or using public transport. If you've been drinking heavily, consider delaying your journey until later in the day to ensure you're safe to drive. Please ensure to report any concerns about others on the road to Police.
- **Protecting Your Property** Unfortunately, opportunistic thefts can rise during the festive period. Keep valuables out of sight in your car, and avoid leaving gifts or shopping bags visible. Secure sheds, garages, and outbuildings, as these can be easy targets for thieves.
