What's going on in Elms Vale & Maxton?

I have a number of loves in my life – my fiancé, my stepson, my puppy and (coming August 2024!) my daughter! However I also love data, and believe that sharing it in a useful way is beneficial for all of us. As such I have delved into my various systems to give you a flavour of what is going on in Elms Vale & Maxton the past 6 weeks or so:

17 crimes were recorded, a variety of offences including a shoplifting from the Co-Op which I'm pleased to say a male was charged with this offence back at the end of February and was sentenced to 14 days imprisonment and to pay compensation to Co-Op.

70 incidents reported to Kent Police, again ranging from missing children to Road Traffic Collisions. I am pleased to see no reported burglaries, though I have noted some reports around dogs which may be dangerous or banned in the Rec. I will keep an eye on this and work with the KCC Dog Warden as required.
