On Friday 8th March 2024, I worked collaboratively with my other beat colleagues and worked a business day of action to target shoplifters. This forms part of the National Business Crime Centre's month of action. Working with uniformed and plain clothes officers, we were able to identify, stop search and bring justice to multiple shoplifters in the act of committing crime.

Good work story/stories

I have spent a lot of time in the Charing area following a spike in antisocial behaviour and neighbour disputes in one specific residential area. Working alongside CID and the local policing team, we have managed to identify multiple crimes taking place and tackle them appropriately. As the local beat officer for the area, I have been heavily involved in the case and was out on foot in that area to reassure the residents and complete antisocial behaviour surveys. The work we have put in over the last month has resulted in arrests being made and the residents in Charing feeling safe, more secure and left them with an increased confidence in the police.
