As part of this, the Beat Team and Neighbourhood Task Force joined up with British Transport Police to tackle these issues with help from a Kent Police Dog Handler. We had a busy afternoon at Ashford Domestic Train Station where a number of persons were searched, however we are proud to say that no knives or weapons were recovered, and a handful of people were dealt with on the day for possession of Cannabis.

PC Moody and PC Hobday have again teamed up with Trading Standards towards the end of this month and seized large quantities of illicit tobacco, vapes and cigarettes across three different venues in the Town Centre. This is something we strongly believe in and will continue to enforce to ensure that these harmful products are not being sold to consumers and especially children as had been reported to us over the last month.
