Recently local officers identified a Moped being ridden in at speed in the Ashford area, and trying to evade Police, using footpaths in their attempts and riding dangerously. Using some local knowledge, local beat officers prevented their escape by plotting up on their expected route, and apprehending them.

This led to a male being arrested for a multitude of offences such as drug driving, possession of cannabis, dangerous driving and other driving offences. This male is now on Police bail and can expect a court date.
